

# Beaded Ornament Hangers

*Add a little sparkle to your tree by using these simple-to-make ornament hangers.*

## **You will need:**

**16-gauge brass craft wire**

**assorted large shiny beads and stars with holes**

**large enough to fit through the wire**

**needlenose pliers**

**wire cutters**

**a pencil**

## **Basic directions:**

***Cut a length of wire*** 5 to 6 inches long.

With pliers, bend over one end to form a loop—

tight enough so the beads will not fall off, but with a bit of a gap to attach your ornament for hanging. Thread on six or seven beads and stars in any configuration and color pattern that you like, reserving about 1-1/2" length of wire at the end.

Hold a pencil at a right angle with the remaining length of wire and bend the wire over the pencil with pliers forming a hook. Attach your ornament to the looped end and you're ready to hang your creation on a tree!
