

# Pincushions with Pizazz

*Use beautiful upholstery fabric scraps to create elegant pincushions. These make nice gifts for a friend who loves to sew.*

## **You will need:**

**5" x 7" or 4" x 8" pieces of upholstery fabrics  
(or any size that you prefer. Note that many fabric stores sell small remnant pieces of assorted, fabrics)**

**cording, ribbon, decorative trims,  
and beads of your choosing**

**polyester fiberfill**

**needle, thread, scissors**

**hot glue gun**

**potpourri (optional)**



## **Basic directions:**

***Cut two identical fabric shapes at 5" x 7"***

***or 4" x 8" (or any size you want). With right sides together,***

***sew all around, leaving about 3" open for turning. If using cording/binding, sew this in place at the same time.***

***Turn, push corners out, and press. Fill snugly with polyester fiberfill, add potpourri if desired, then hand stitch the opening to close it. Use a hot glue gun to glue on additional trims, ribbons, and gem-style beads.***
